# A BLAST!!!

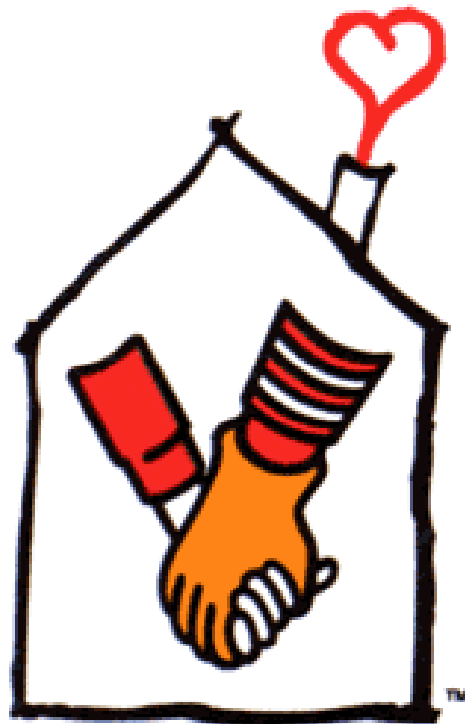
