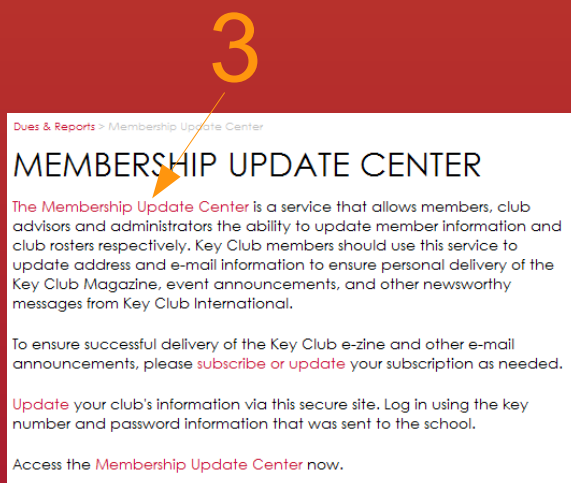
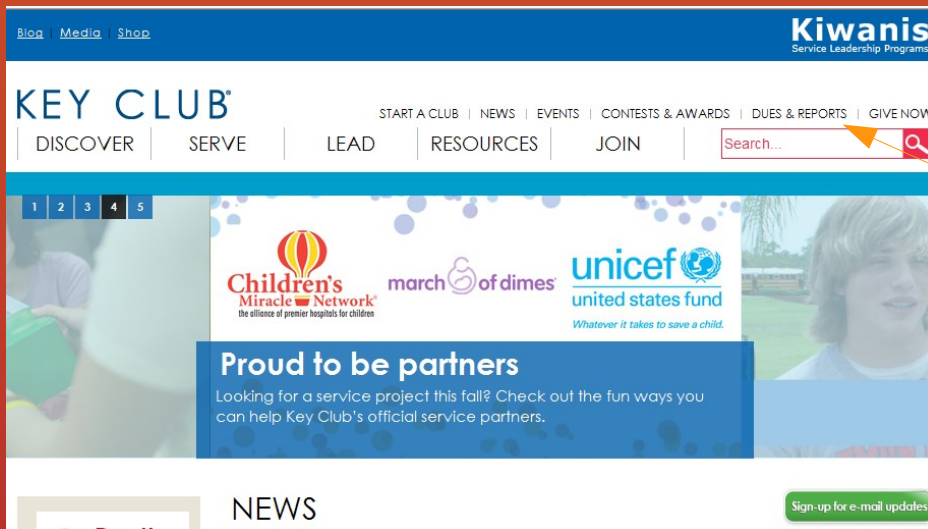

HOW TO COMPLETE CLUB DUES

First of all you will need to go to www.keyclub.org. Then you will want to go to the Dues & Reports on the top of the page. After that you click Membership Update Center. Then you click the Membership Update Center again. You can see the pictures below to help.

PROJECT LIFE UPDATE

Project Life was created back in 2000, when a group of Key Clubbers at Leadership Conference when they realized that there was a problem in their states. That problem was suicide. Since the creation of Project Life many others have seen the importance of this project, and have lent their hands to help. Since then, we, as a state, have gone from being the state with the highest per capita suicide rate in the country to the third, and with your help, we can lower that number even further.

Currently, Project Life is planning big. Recently, at our summer board meeting, we talked to Carl Rosston, who is the suicide prevention coordinator of the state. He has given us a great deal of ideas, along with a great deal of information. We plan to try and get more schools involved with a program the state offers called SOS, or Signs of Suicide. This program is a training program in which teachers, and sometimes student, are taught the warning signs of suicide, along with what to do in the event of a suicide. Rosston also told us of his plans for the state, some of these including advertising the Montana Suicide Hotline on FaceBook, and also the idea of possibly running ads (both television and radio) in more areas of Montana. I can safely speak for the rest of the committee by saying I look forward to working closely with both Carl Rosston and other suicide awareness and anti-bullying programs statewide.
