

Dear Potential International Attendee:

The Mighty Montana District of Key Club International is getting set for its annual Tour to the International Convention. This year it will be held in Orlando, FL. It is not too early to begin raising funds for this once-in-a-lifetime trip, so start asking your Key Club, sponsoring Kiwanis Club, and local businesses for the assistance. Most important of all, ask your parents; they can be your best resource. Remember to inform your Key Club Advisor and also make arrangements with your summer employer, if applicable, to take 11 days off during the summer. The trip runs from June 29th through July 9th. Space is limited and there has been a lot of interest in this year's trip, so please contact Mary Brady immediately if you are thinking of going. The cost of the tour this year is \$800 plus the cost of your plane flight to Orlando and your meals.

NEW THIS YEAR You are responsible for booking your own flight to Orlando. You may book this flight at any time (the sooner you book, the less expensive it will probably be) and from any airport, however the flight should get you into Orlando on Friday, June 29th and leave on Monday, July 9th. These are the dates of the tour and all flights must be booked within those dates.

Once you have booked your flight,

- 1) Send a confirmation email to Mary Brady with flight information, so we can make arrangements to pick up people as they arrive.
- 2) Fill out the online form below, print it and send it with a \$200 deposit to Ed Leland. This deposit is refundable until April 15th. Your plane ticket **IS PROBABLY NOT REFUNDABLE**. Make sure you are serious about going before purchasing. This year's tour will **not** be cancelled.

Deadlines for non-refundable deposits of \$300 each are May 1st and June 1st.

- Convention fees
- 2-day hopper pass for Disney Parks
- 2-day hopper pass for Universal Studio Parks

- Lodging for all days of the tour
- Transportation between venues
- A day at an Atlantic coast beach
- Some meals during convention, including food and refreshments in the Montana District Suite
