### **Code of Conduct**

1. All participants are required to take part in all scheduled events unless physically unable to do so.
2. No Key Clubber will leave the conference area without the accompaniment of one of the adult advisors.
3. No alcoholic beverages or drugs of any nature, with the exception of prescribed medication will be permitted in the possession of anyone attending the camp. Anyone under the influence of any non-prescribed drug (including alcohol) will be immediately sent home.
4. Gambling, use of fireworks, in brief, any action unbecoming to a Key Clubber will not be tolerated.
5. The curfew of midnight will be observed, and Key Clubbers are to remain in their rooms until 6 AM.
6. Under no circumstances will males be allowed into the females' living quarters nor will females be allowed into males' quarters.
7. If the Key Clubber drives his/her own car, the car must be parked immediately upon arrival and will not to be used until departure..
8. No conduct unbecoming of a Key Clubber will be tolerated.
9. No sexual activity on any type will be allowed.
