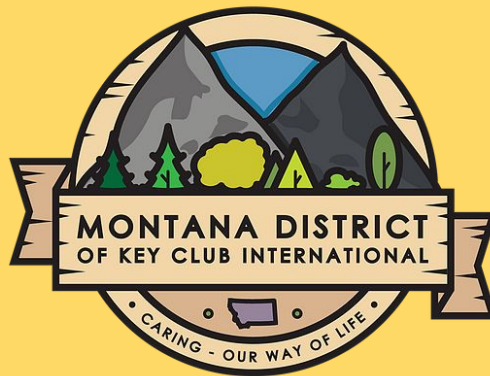




# *Executive Committee*



We work on maintaining communication between each K-family and ensuring that everything is moving. We work on finding things that could be worked out with the help of each family and serve our communities together.




# Our 3 Goals
