WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

1. What is an International convention?

Every summer, Key Club International celebrates a year of service at the international convention. Approximately 700 students and their advisors will gather together to introduce new programs, present awards to outstanding clubs, conduct the organization's business, attend educational workshops, and elect international officers for the upcoming year.

2. When and where will it be held?

3. When should we register?

You MUST BE A DUES PAID MEMBER to attend! Members are encouraged to submit their forms and fees immediately. The convention registration fee of \$275 (USD) will be in effect until Friday, May 30, 2025.

4. How do we register?

5. What does the fee cover?

The \$1,263 (US) fees will cover the airline tickets (\$625 approx.), the cost of a quad room accommodation for 6 nights (Cost per person with tax the total is \$315), 4 meals (3 breakfasts and one lunch while the conference), ground transportation(\$49), registration (\$275), all convention sessions, forums, entertainment, and dances. Additional fees may apply for excursions like The Magic Kingdom or other parks and we recommend approximately \$50 per day for food (\$200-\$300).

6. Can fees be refunded?

Requests sent to Michelle Preston, Co-District Administrator, (at michelle_preston@gfps.k12.mt.us). No refunds will be granted for requests received after June 6, 2025.

7. How do we get there?

Airline tickets will be purchased by the District Administrators. We will attempt to locate reasonable flights from Bozeman (most central and affordable) and for the group to travel together. There will be a meeting to discuss once the group is finalized. Flight will leave June 30 and return July 6.

8. How do we make hotel reservations?

All hotel reservations must be made by completing the registration form and returning to the MT District Administrator. <u>The convention hotel will not accept reservations directly</u>, so do not call them for reservations. Hotel room fees are included in your registration fee and are dependent on the number of people in the room (see the registration form)

9. Can we select our roommates?

Yes, Key Clubbers must indicate their roommate preferences on the registration form, and all roommates must submit their forms at the same time. If your roommate preference is not made on the registration form, the District Administrator will assign roommates randomly. The District Administrator will not assign adult roommates in a Key Clubbers room. Adults must register for either Double or Single Occupancy. No roommate changes will be permitted.

10. Can we register to attend outside of the district "tour"?

No, all Key Clubbers must register with the District Tour, and we cannot accept hotel points, or any other form of payment to reduce the registration or reduce the cost. All rates are based on everyone utilizing the same hotels, admissions, etc.

This year's convention promises to be lots of fun! The package is \$1,263 (US). The fees are payable in full NO LATER THAN Friday, JUNE 6, 2025. If you wish to be included in the package, you must complete the attached registration and medical release form and send fees to MT District KEY CLUB NO LATER THAN MAY 29, 2025.
