- The Montana District Key Club Board has been evaluating the role of the advisors at YC, District Convention, and other district events. The following are guidelines that we are recommending for advisors during this year's District Convention.
- Room checks should be performed at curfew (11:30PM). Advisors/chaperones are recommended to go in pairs, with one male and one female. Make sure that all of the people that are assigned to a room are in that room, and confirm that either visually or, if in shower, verbally. It is also recommended that the advisor actually enter the room and do a quick, stand in place, search.
- We ask that a number of advisors do hall patrol after curfew each night of the convention. Please let the Sergeant-at-Arms know if you would be able to do this.
- Please do not have Key Clubbers change rooming assignments—if there is a need please let the District Administrators know and we will make change arrangements if possible.
- During general sessions, workshop sessions, and caucuses it is asked that the advisors check to see that all members from your club or division are present. All Key Club members at Convention are required to attend these functions.
- We also encourage advisors to help chaperone events: We need adults to help us with our events, such as:
 - Talent show
 - Dance
 - Caucus Rooms
 - Workshops (please feel free to attend, the adult presence really helps)
 - Contest Judging – We have several contests that are judged at the convention. If you are interested in being a judge for any, please mark the appropriate box, and we will try to make it happen:
